## **Charters and Dispensations**

Right Eminent Grand Commander, Officers, Past Grand Commanders and Sir Knights all.

This year the Grand Commander has issued three dispensation for Commanderies to operate as a Commandery Under Dispensation.

Lawrence V. Kaminsky, UD is to be a research and holding Commandery and is not expected to confer the Orders nor receive a Charter.

Levant Preceptory, UD is to use as its official uniform, ceremonial robes conforming to and consistent with the historical traditions and practices of Templary. It is to assist Commanderies when requested to Confer the Order of the Temple in ceremonial robes.

Tipton Commandery, UD is to operate as a Commandery until such time as they shall prove themselves a viable Commandery and receive a Charter. This Dispensation expired April 24, 2020 and has not been renewed.

What with key members moving because of work and the other concerns, Tipton has voted to close and not to seek a Charter.

Connersville Commandery #6 has service notice that they will be consolidating their Commandery with Richmond Commandery #8. The Grand Commander has appointed Sir Knight Phillip Whisner as Special Deputy to oversee the process.

## **Membership Committee Report**

Right Eminent Grand Commander, Officers and Sir Knights of the Grand Line, Distinguished Guests, Sir Knights all,

It is a pleasure to serve the Grand Commandery and all the Sir Knights in the State as Membership Committee Chairman for 2020/2021. As each of us knows, the Covid-19 Pandemic made 2020 an extremely challenging year. With Commanderies unable to meet and personal lives of Sir Knights and their families turned upside down, our plans for increasing membership were not fully enacted.

Sadly, we were only able to confer Knighthood on seven of our Masonic Brothers. In planning for the eventual re-opening of Commanderies around the state, I had the opportunity to reach out to each Eminent Commander and Recorder to remind them of the importance of having a local Membership Committee with a Chair that has a strong desire to increase our ranks.

During our downtime, I was also able to work closely with Right Eminent Grand Commander Fodrea to put together a program that may help us to increase the number of Sir Knights that are likely to actively participate in the Conclaves of the 34 Commanderies across Indiana.

## **Proposed Mentor Program**

The purpose of the Mentor Program is to increase membership in the York Rite - not just in quantity but in quality. We often find ourselves signing petition after petition and steering the candidates to the Tri-State Festival to quickly and easily get them Knighted. Oftentimes that is where it ends. Without a solid mentor, the new Sir Knight struggles to find his way in the York Rite and does not fully participate in our order.

This program is designed to increase membership by challenging every Sir Knight in Indiana to find just one Master Mason to introduce to the York Rite and to Mentor him through the process. There is legislation to be presented which will authorize a new jewel/bar that may be worn on your uniform for successfully completing this program. If approved this program will begin in April after the 2021/2022 Grand Conclave.

To qualify for the Mentor Jewel, you must Top Line Sign a Candidate's Petition and carry it to your local York Rite. After a successful vote you must then assist the Candidate in receiving the degrees and orders in Chapter, Council, and Commandery. This can be accomplished by travelling with your Protegee to attend degrees presented singularly or to attend events like the Tri-State Festival to receive degrees in a group.

After your Protegee is Knighted, you will then have several milestones to achieve with the new Sir Knight. The complete list of criteria are still being developed but will include activities in Chapter, Council, and Commandery to be completed with each protegee for the Sir Knight Mentor to earn the Mentor Jewel.

Potential Criteria for Earning the Mentor Jewel (Note, this is only a partial list):

- Explain all the signs, words, and penalties for each Degree/Order and have the Sir Knight Protegee commit all to memory for Chapter, Council, and Commandery.
- Attend with your Protegee at least three meetings for Chapter, Council, and Commandery.
- Visit another York Rite for a Stated Meeting or Degree work.
- Attend at least one Grand Event.
- Attend inspection for two of the three bodies.
- Commit to memory the 11 offices of the Commandery and plot them on a chart. Match the Jewel to the Office. (same for Chapter and Council)
- Learn proper sword use Learn the Sword Manual
- Learn how to decipher the lost word.
- More criteria to come as the program is further developed.

If the Mentor Program is adopted and well publicized, and we have good participation, we have the potential to significantly increase the number of Sir Knights in the Great State of Indiana.

## **PROPOSED LEGISLATION**

## Proposal #1: Resolution to establish quorum for Business meetings Section 820(1)

In accordance with Section 66 of the Bylaws of Grand Encampment which allows a Grand Commandery to reduce the number of Sir Knights necessary to constitute a quorum for conducting the business of the Commandery to a number less than nine but not less than five. A Grand Commandery may only implement this provision legislatively. Nine Sir Knights constitute a Commandery and are required to establish a Commandery or confer the Orders of Knighthood.

Therefore, we propose the following addition to Section 820 of the Bylaws of the Indiana Grand Commandery through this Resolution that for the purpose of conducting a Business meeting only, there must be no less than five Sir Knight present to constitute a quorum for the business meeting.

## Proposal #2: Add to section 920 (c1) RETURNED TO COMMITTEE - TABLED UNTIL NEXT YEAR

Holy Land Pilgrimage Jewel 920 (c1)

In order to promote certain advantages for the welfare of the Grand Commandery in general, the Constituent Commanderies and Sir Knights in particular, there is hereby submitted to this Grand Commandery Conclave a proposal to establish a "HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE JEWEL" for the Grand Commandery of Indiana. (A) The Jewel should be presented only in consideration of loyal and financial support to the Holy Land Pilgrimage program. There is three level of support 1) \$250.00 2) \$500.00 3) \$1000.00. For a donation of two hundred and fifty dollars the donor shall receive a jewel with a back ribbon. For a donation of five hundred dollars the donor shall receive a jewel with a red ribbon. The donation will be accumulative totals. In lieu of jewel the donor may wear the bar. See below



SECTION 920 (d) (RESOLUTION No. 10) WEARING OF JEWELS A person may not simultaneously wear more jewels than can be fit in a single line in the appropriate place on the standard Templar Uniform. For many Sir Knights this entails choosing which jewels to wear or omit. Any jewels that are worn should be in the following sequence from the wearer's right to left. The wearer's right is the edge closest to the center of the uniform front. Centered above the jewels, a Sir Knight may wear approved service bars. Only three bars may be worn in a row, but multiple rows are permitted. Service bars should be worn in the order listed from the top rows down and from the wearer's right to left. Thus, if multiple rows are worn, the highest ranked bars are in the top row.
