Passing of Sir Knight Ronald Lee Ellis, KCT Past Grand Commander 2004-2005

Ronald Lee Ellis, 84, of Columbus, passed away Thursday February 22, 2024. He was born September 23, 1939 in Columbus to B. Gail and Bessie (Adams) Ellis. They preceded him in death.

Mr. Ellis earned his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees from Purdue University. He retired from both Arvin Industries and NTN Driveshaft. He was also a member of the First United Methodist Church of Columbus.
