Sir Knights from across the state gather for the Arch of Steel for Grand Commander, Mike Robbins, and (now Past) Grand Master, Carl Culmann.










Congratulations Sir Knight Tony & Lady Stacey!





Congenital Hereditary Endothelia Dystrophy

On May 29, 2019 we had the honor of presenting a Career Starter Grant in the amount of \$65,000.00 from the Knights Templar Eye Foundation to Raji Shyam, Phd. Doctor Shyam is a Post-Doctoral Fellow at the Joseph Bonanno Laboratory located at Indiana University School of Optometry. She is researching the causes and possible treatment of Congenital Hereditary Endothelia Dystrophy or (CHED). We would like to congratulate her on receiving this grant and wish her success in her research.

We also want to thank Dr. Bonanno for a tour of the laboratory to see not only Dr. Shyam's work, but also some of the other inspiring and encouraging research that is being conducted on early diagnosis and treatment for pediatric vision problems.

To the Sir Knights of Indiana, I want to thank you for your support in this great work. Without your contributions, this research would not be possible. These grants are not easy to earn. This past year there were over 40 applications for Career Starter Grants nationwide. The applications are then reviewed by the Knights Templar Eye Foundation Scientific Advisory Committee which consists of 10 Physicians and Research Scientists, who then make recommendations as to who should receive the grant. There were only 20 grants presented this year. So, you can see this is a very competitive process.

We would like to once again congratulate Dr. Shyam on receiving the grant and to the staff and faculty of the Indiana University School of Optometry.
